

**BUSINESS FRONTAGE/BUSINESS SITE
IMPROVEMENT PROJECT
- SIGNAGE GRANT -**

The Johnston County Industrial Authority (JCIA), as an economic development organization is, as part of its purpose, interested in assisting current Johnston County businesses in improving their building or grounds. The project that is being funded by the JCIA is designed to assist the business owner, or occupying building owner, with improving the image of their business and/or location site. This project will enable prospective participants to have monies to enhance that portion of their business that face the thoroughfare. The idea is to improve the storefront business/site so that it might be more attractive and assist in increased sales or service for the owner. This increased attractiveness of county businesses will also aid in drawing prospective new business to the county and county towns.

The monies are available throughout the Johnston County Industrial Authority footprint. Funding decisions are final. Applicants not receiving funding may reapply in subsequent years as additional funds become available.

THIS APPLICATION IS FOR SIGNAGE ONLY AND CANNOT BE PAIRED WITH ANY OTHER CURRENT JCIA GRANT.

The individual business must complete an application for request of funds and submit it to the Johnston County Chamber of Commerce office, which is serving as a collection point for the applications. A committee appointed by the JCIA will review the requests and fund those that are viable and have the greatest impact on enhancing the business property in Johnston County. Upon award notification, the business owner/building owner agrees to pay one-half of the funds back to the JCIA by the end of one year from the date of receipt of funds. No interest will accrue on the amount that represents the required one-half payback. Projects will only be funded to the level of the monies made available by the JCIA. ***The maximum amount of funding is \$1,000.00 per business.*** Businesses may submit projects in which the JCIA funding would be part of a larger project.

The deadline for application is July 3, 2019. Award notification will be made by July 17, 2019.

This Project Is Not Intended For Tax-Supported Entities.

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If the applicant is not the owner of the building, the building owner MUST sign application along with business owner.
